Six degree founder Andrew Weinreich, sometimes referred to as the father of social networking, created his platform to help people connect with people they did not know.

The more time spent on social media can lead to cyberbullying, social anxiety, depression, and exposure to content that is not age appropriate. Social media is addictive when you're playing a game or accomplishing a task you seek to do it as well as you can.

Fake news is frequently used to target minorities and has become a significant cause of localised violence as well as large scale riots.

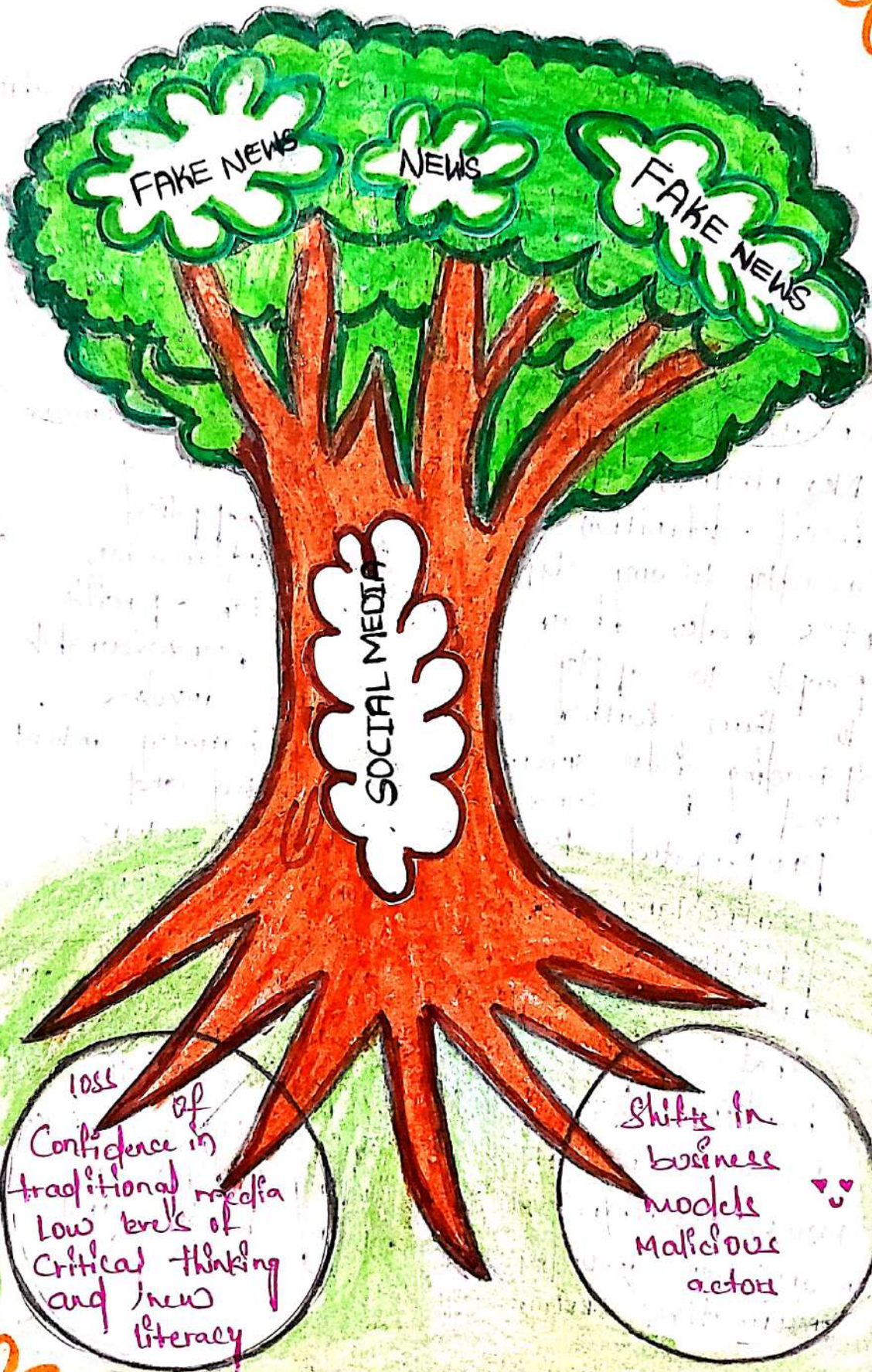


False News is false or misleading information presented as news. False news often has the aim of damaging the reputation of a person or entity, or making money through advertising revenue. Although false news has always been spread throughout history, the term 'false news' was first used in the 1890s when sensational reports in newspapers were common.

Nevertheless, the term does not have a fixed definition and has been applied broadly to any type of false information. It's also been used by high-profile people to apply to any news unfavourable to them. Further disinformation involves spreading false information with harmful intent and is sometimes generated and

propagated by hostile foreign actors, particularly during elections. In some definitions, false news includes satirical articles misinterpreted as genuine and articles that employ sensationalist or clickbait headlines that are not supported in the text.

Because of this diversity of types of false news, researchers are beginning to favour information disorder as a more neutral and informative term.

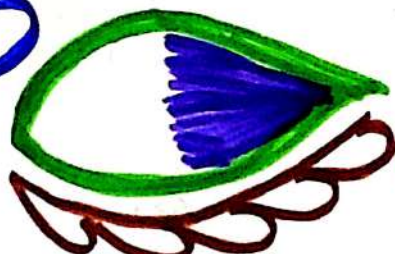
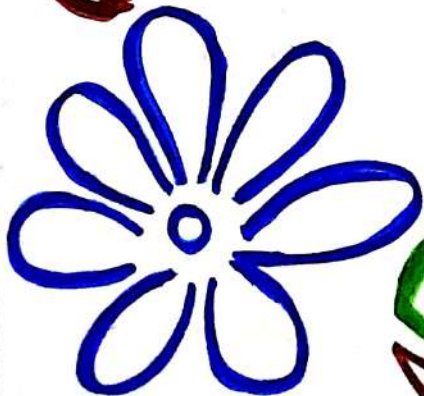

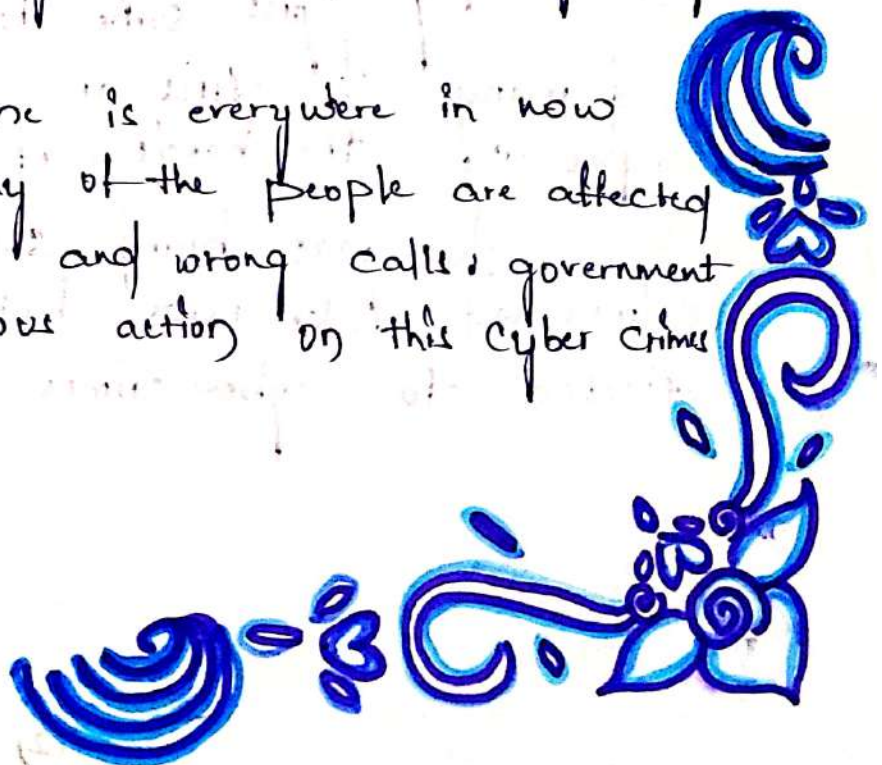

Cyber crime is everywhere in now-a-days. many of the people are affected by these links and wrong calls. government should take serious action on this cyber crimes.






Case 2 :-

One house wife was became a ~~IT~~ by using social media she was taken IT classes.

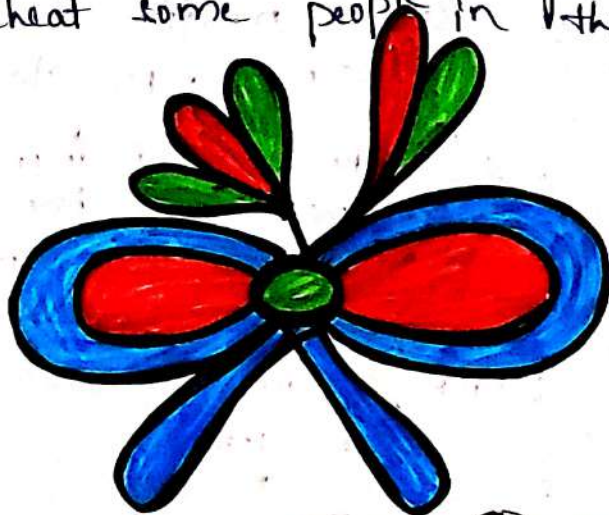
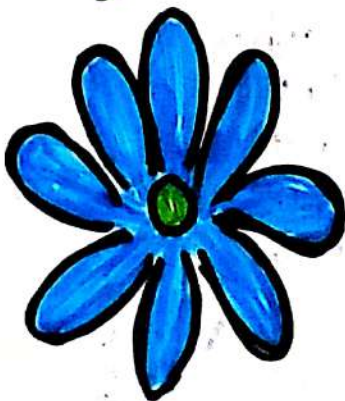

⇒ Bank should give awareness to know about cyber crimes:

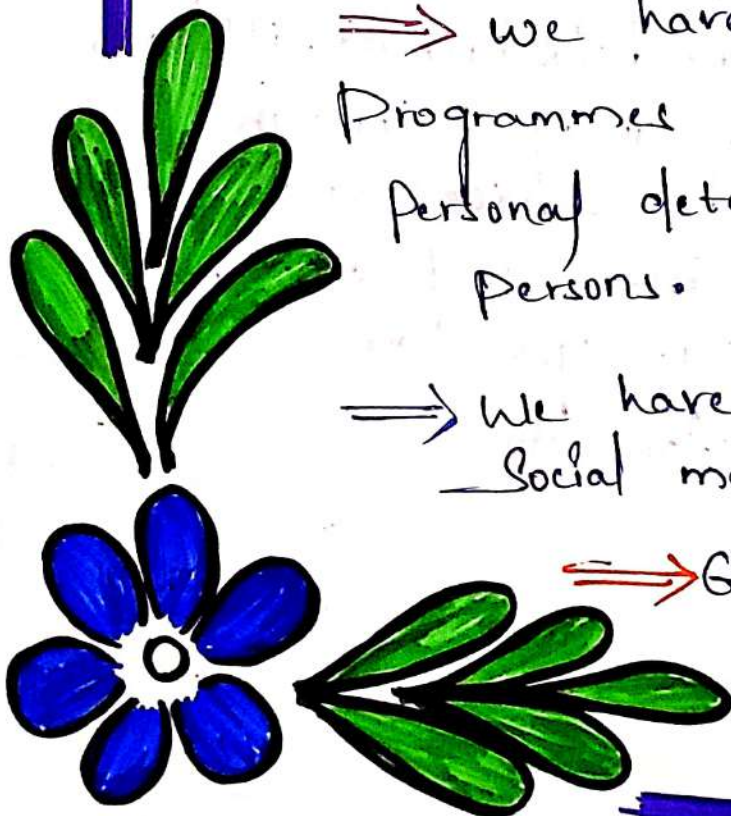
⇒ Government should create any app to don't allow any unnecessary videos or app to our mobile without our permission
