COVA Peace Network organised Sambandh annual inter-school & inter-collegiate competitions in the city on Tuesday. The theme for Swami Agnivesh and Praful Bidwai Memorial Annual Sambandh competitions was 'How can Students Check Different Forms of Violence in Society?'

About 1,500 students from 59 schools and colleges have participated in the competitions.

Events included debates, declamation, quiz, essay writing, one act plays, posters with slogans and the topics were different types of violence in society and their impact, the major conflicts in India and how can they be addressed.

The most common refrain that emerged from all the presentations and deliberations of students was concern about growing differences about over communal, caste, gender issues within society and decrease in interactions within different communities, groups and classes. The students took a pledge to interact with and befriend at least one person from another community and contribute to better understanding for a harmonious and peaceful society.
